

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR UWC SHOLARSHIPS 2022

DESCRIPTION

The UWC Togo National Committee has opened the applications to select the third cohort of students for the UWC (United World Colleges) schools and colleges (18 schools and colleges spread over four continents <u>www.tg.uwc.org</u>). UWC **TOGO** allows Togolese students regardless of their social class or the economic level of their family to obtain the International Baccalaureate (IB) and to continue their studies in major universities around the world. In addition, **UWC educational model** allows students to live a transformative life experience through both academic excellence and service values. Togo National Committee aims to build a class of young Togolese leaders who will work together to transform the future of their community. The laureates will receive a full or partial two-year scholarship to one of the UWC schools or Colleges for the academic year 2022-2023.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The applicant must:

- Be a Togolese citizen or an ECOWAS citizen residing in Togo for at least two years;
- Be in Seconde (2nde), Première (1ère) or Terminale in the Togolese education system or the French education system (or equivalent level in other educational systems), at the time of submission of the application;
- Be between the ages of 16 and 18 years by July 31, 2022 (between 1st January 2004 and July 31, 2006)
- Have obtained a general minimum average of 12/20 (for the Togolese education system) or 14/20 (for the French education system or the equivalent in other educational systems) over the previous years of secondary school (from 6e to last year class).

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

The following documents are required:

- A birth certificate
- A passport size photo
- A certificate of nationality (if available)
- A valid passport or national identity card (if available)

- All transcripts for secondary school classes from grade 6e to the class done last year 2020/2021
- Forms to be completed online by the applicant via <u>www.tg.uwc.org</u>. Please read "Guide du candidat" before starting to apply.
- Recommendations forms to be filled out online by parents and teachers (the principal and the English teacher)
- The parents of applicants who have been shortlisted for the interview stage will complete a financial assessment form.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

The selection of students for UWC high school scholarships is done in two stages:

- The first step is based on the evaluation of the application and the minimum academic performance. It counts for 40% in the final selection.
- The second stage will be conducted by the selection committee, which will organize individual interviews with the shortlisted candidates and define the evaluation activities for these candidates. It accounts for 60% in the final ranking of candidates.

METHOD OF SUBMISSION

- The required documents must be uploaded online.
